For written work, students are encouraged to use **bonpatron.ca** to improve the text, and **wordreference.com** for translating words within a context. <u>Translation sites such as Babblefish are not appropriate.</u> Please note as well that your son/daughter has signed a school-wide policy on academic integrity and plagiarism. Should your son/daughter need assistance, I am happy to help him/her analyse, write, and edit work.

C) Exams:

Though exams begin on January 30th, a portion of the exam for this course (worth 30% of the final mark) will be done in class the week prior. There is an emphasis on film, so any extra film study at home (en français) would not only be fun but also beneficial.
